BUSINESS

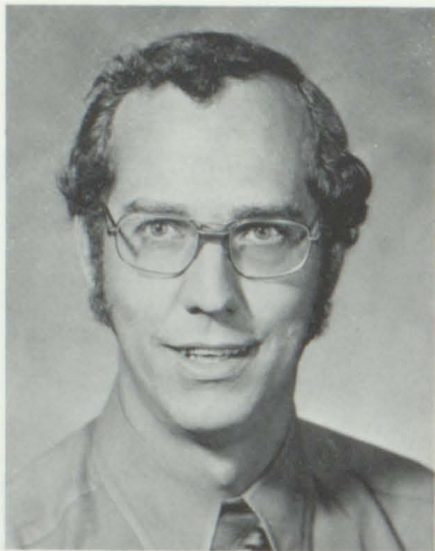

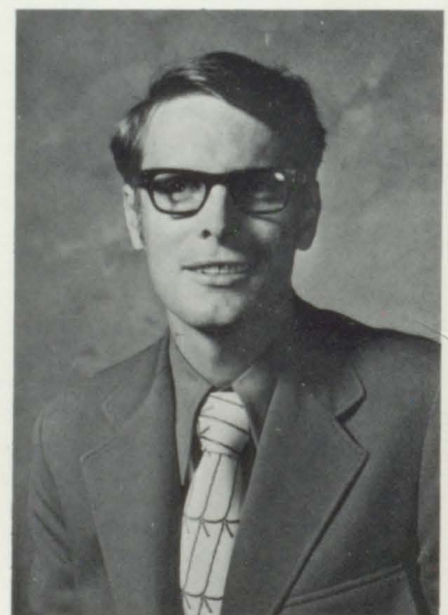

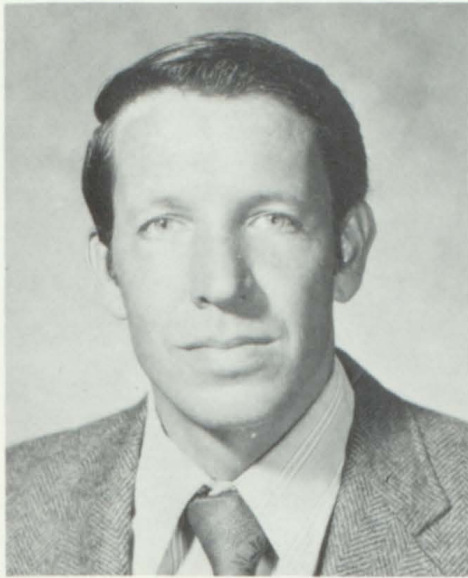

Courses offered are one year of General Mathematics, two years of Algebra, one semester of Trigonometry and one semester of senior Algebra.

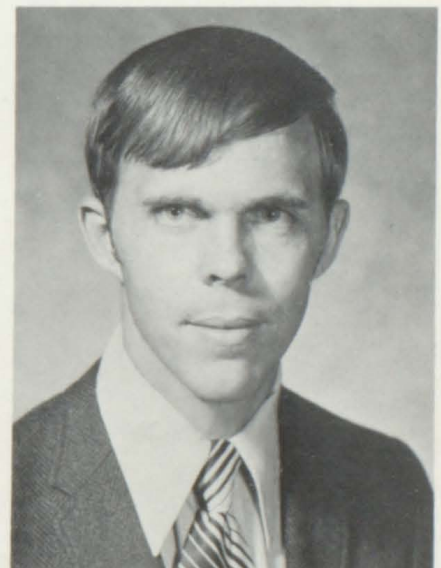

FOREIGN LANGUAGE

In the Spanish classes, students are trained to understand, speak, read, and write Spanish fluently in record time under a new method recently perfected at Tennessee High and not available elsewhere. Thus far, many students have had high placement in college and contests.

The objective of the French program is mastery of basic skills, working toward correct and fluent use of the language.

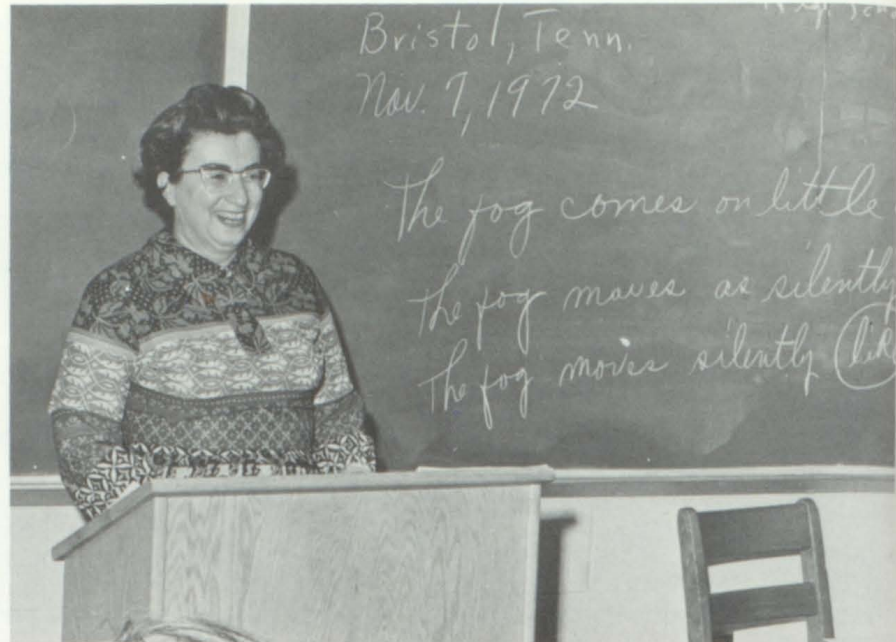
A new addition to the foreign language department is Mythology. The program gives a deeper understanding of Latin background and culture.

ENGLISH

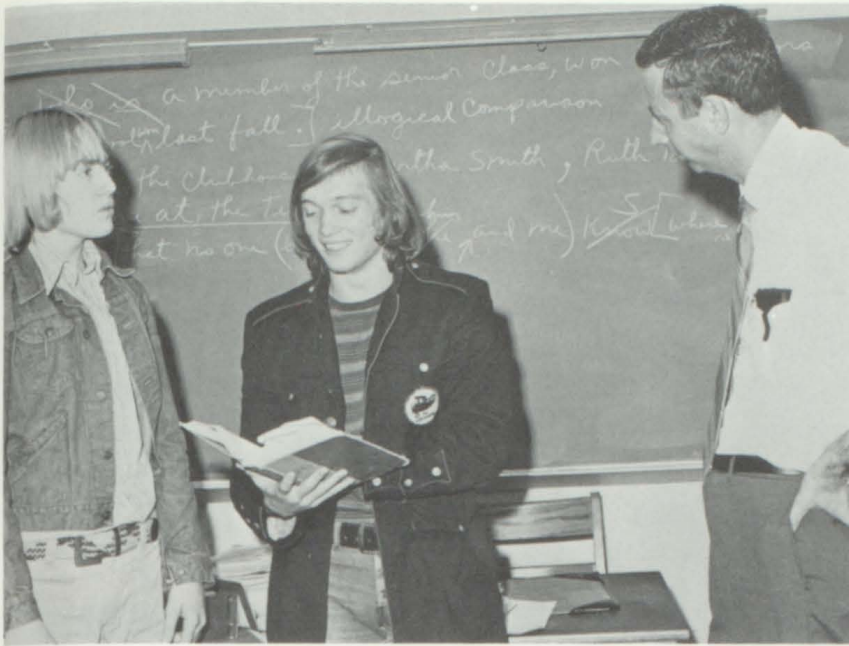

LIBRARY

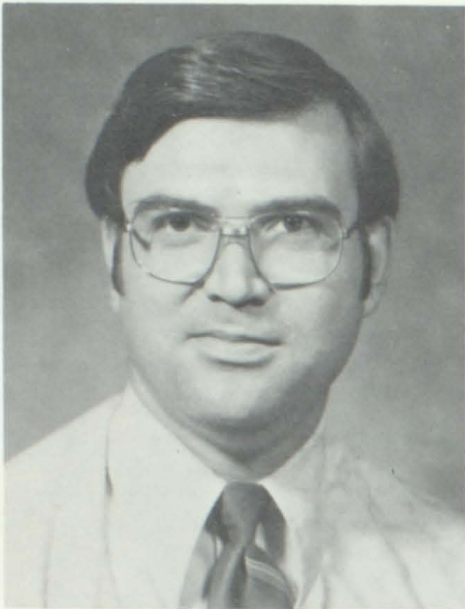
