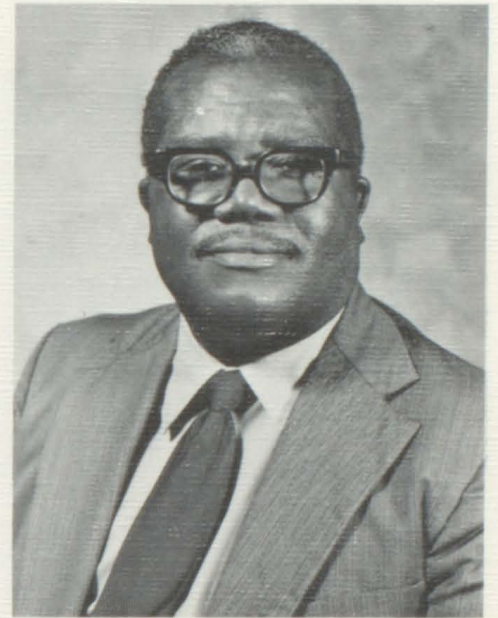
ENGLISH

SOCIAL STUDIES

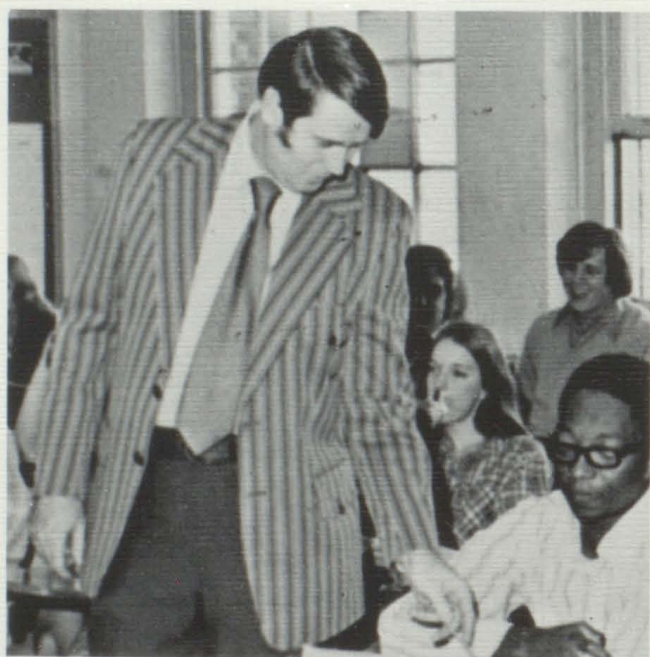
