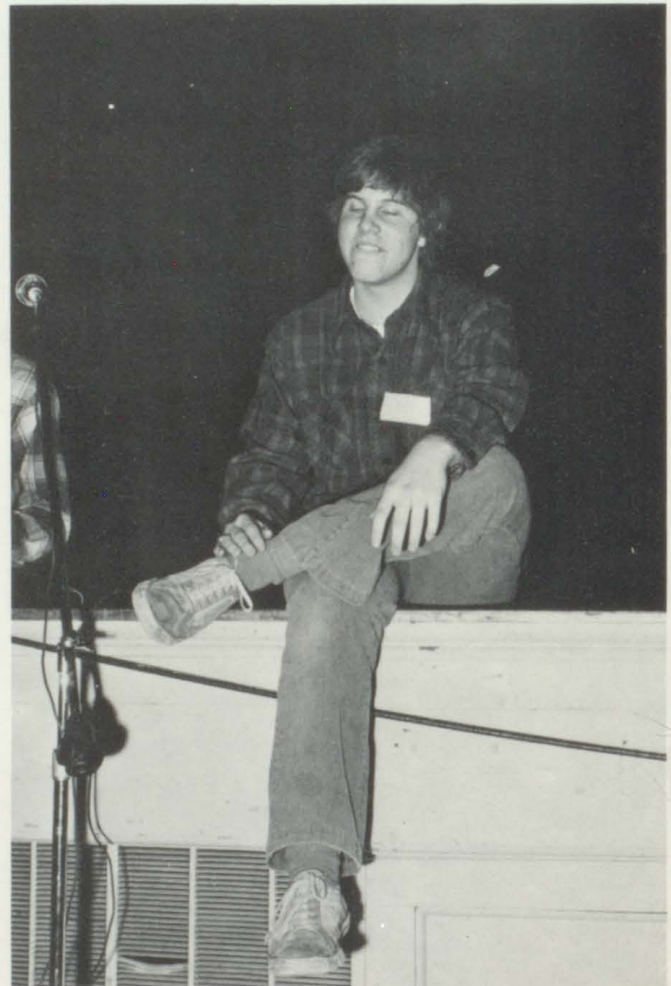

SCIENCE DEPARTMENT

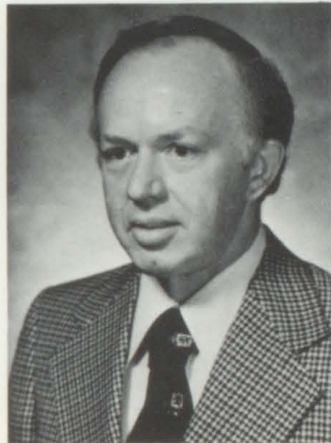

HISTORY DEPARTMENT

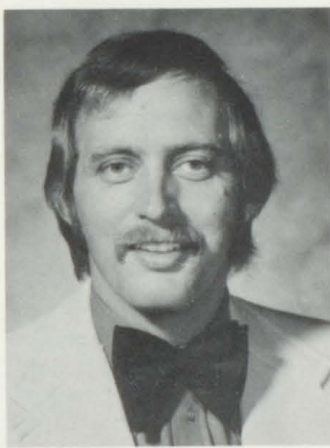
