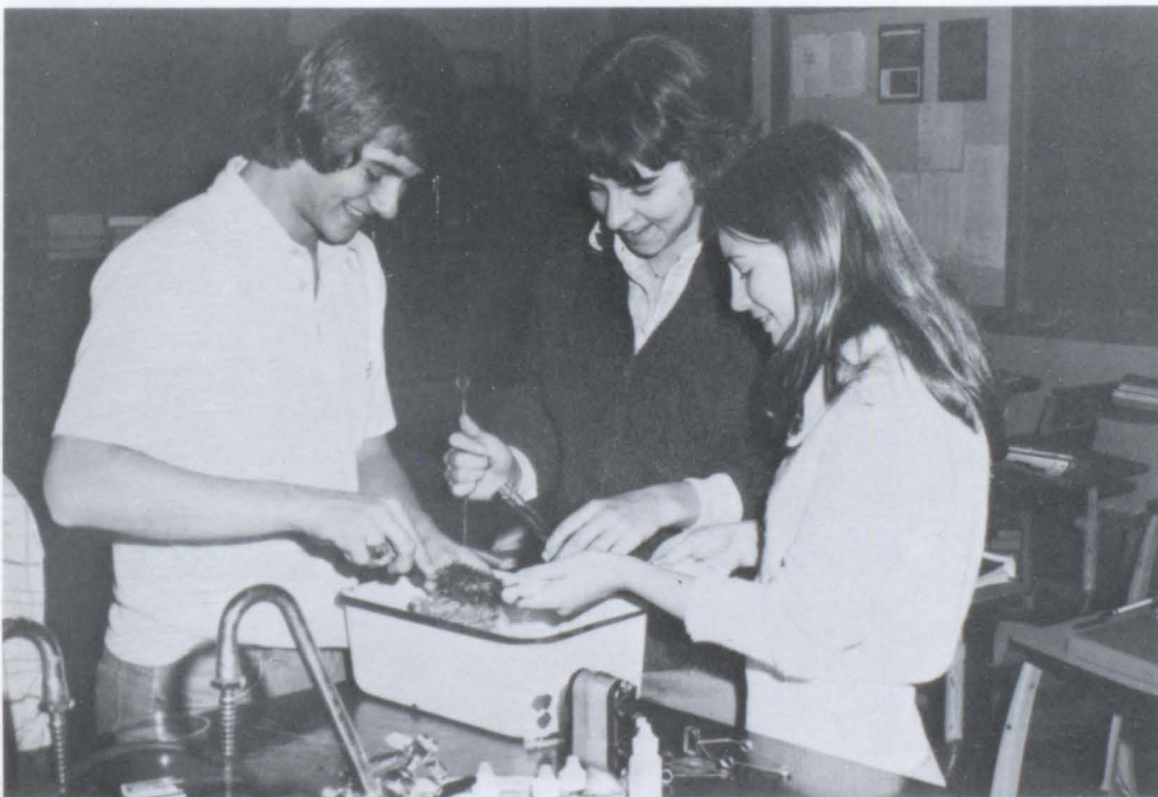

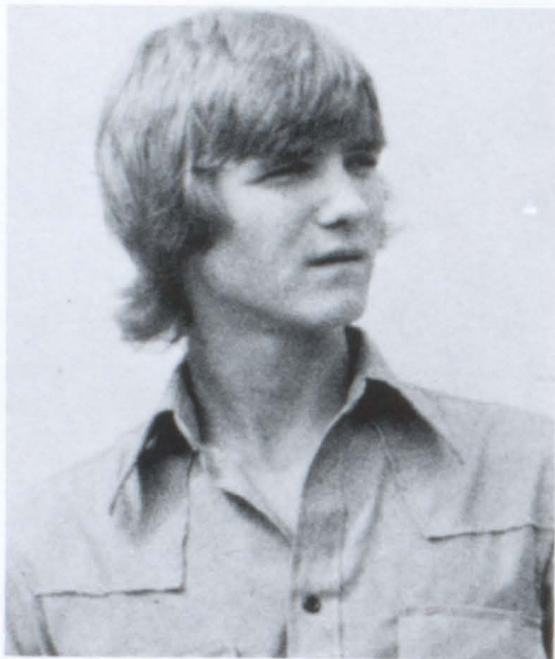

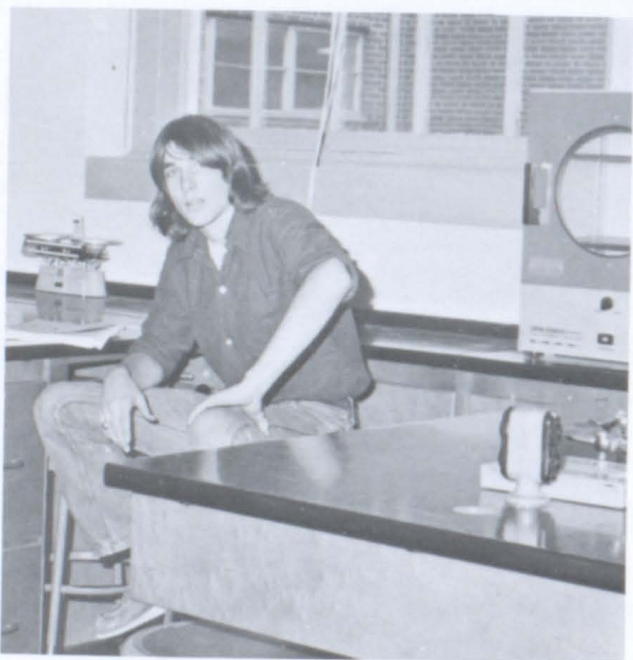

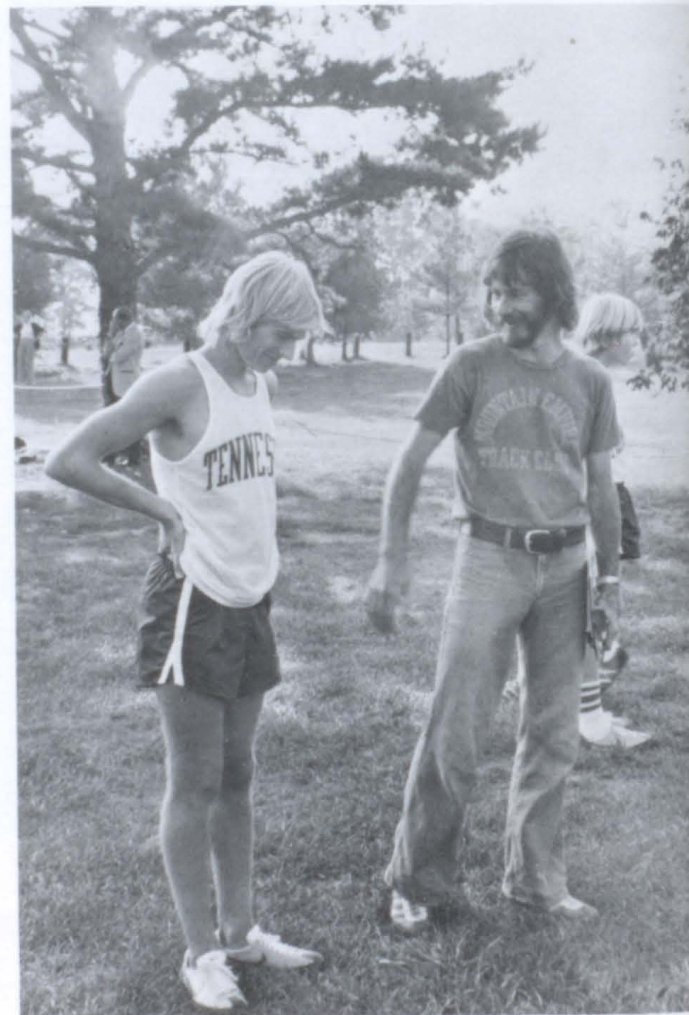
A. F. S. STUDENT'S HAVE SHORT STAY IN AMERICA.

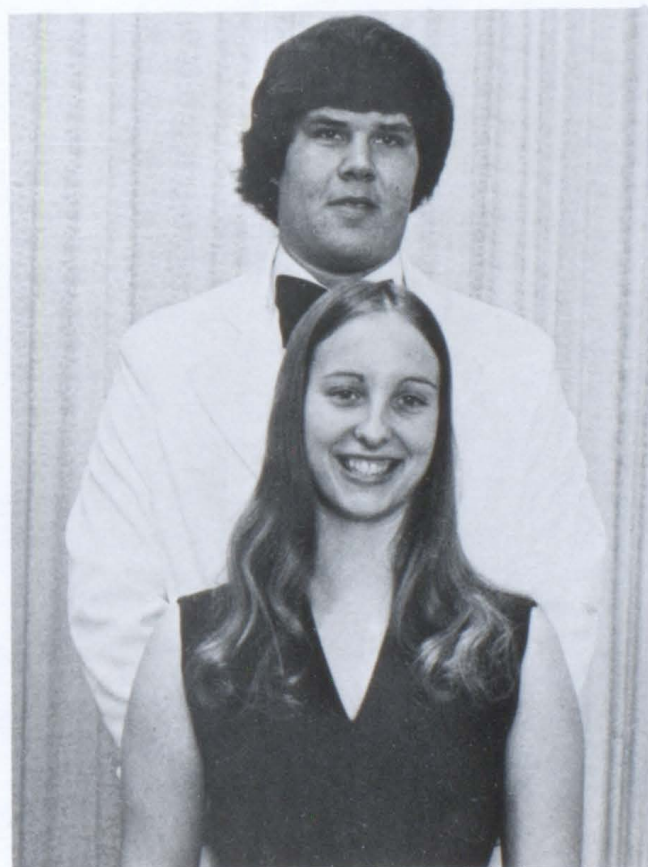

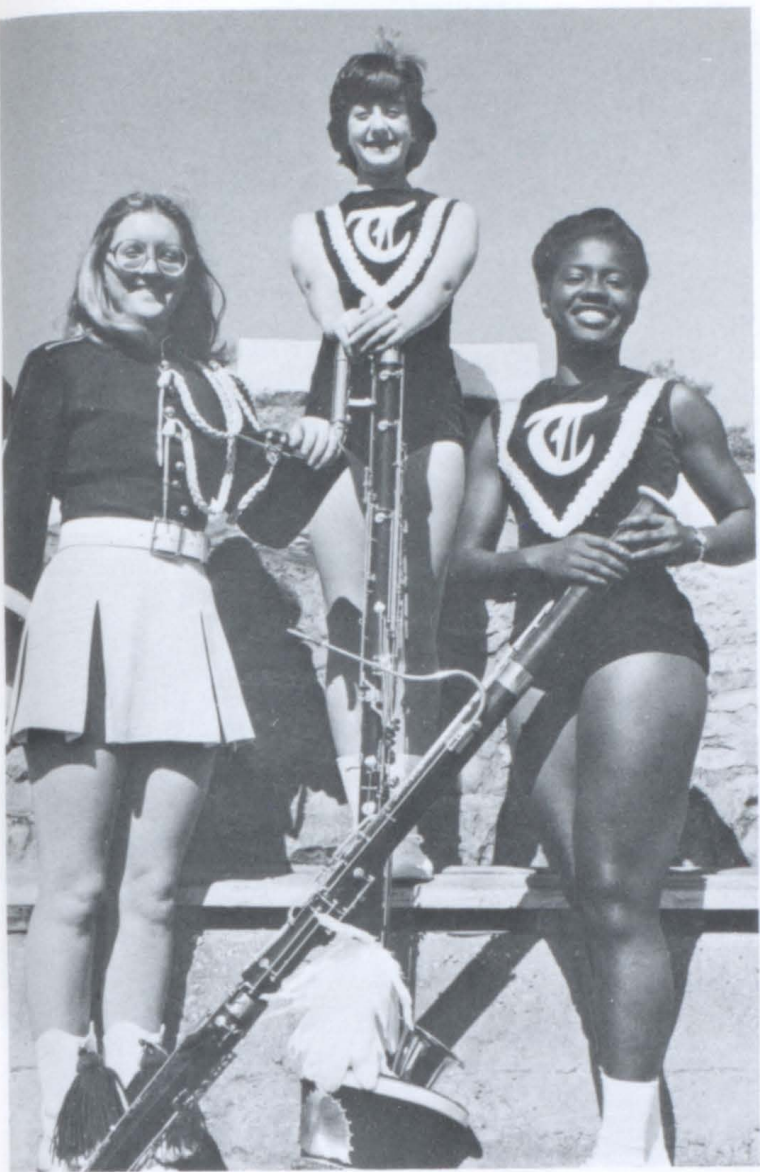
