Libby Hodge was chairman of the costume committee and Sara Daniels and Sandra Steele were make-up artists for the play.



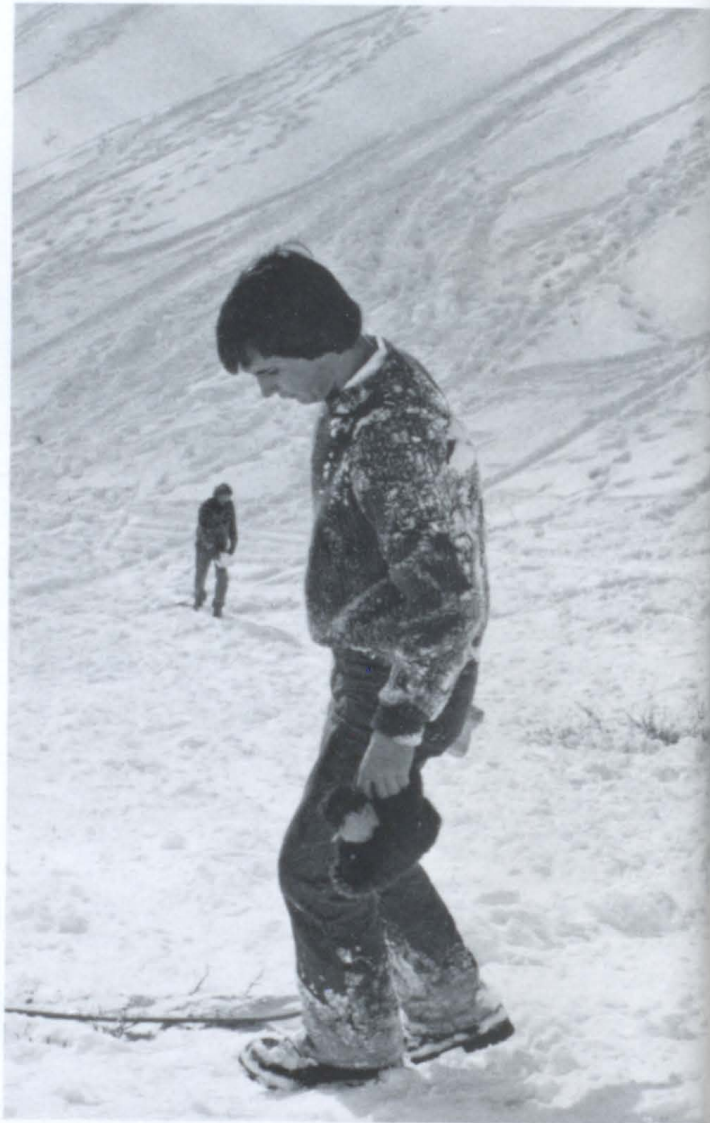

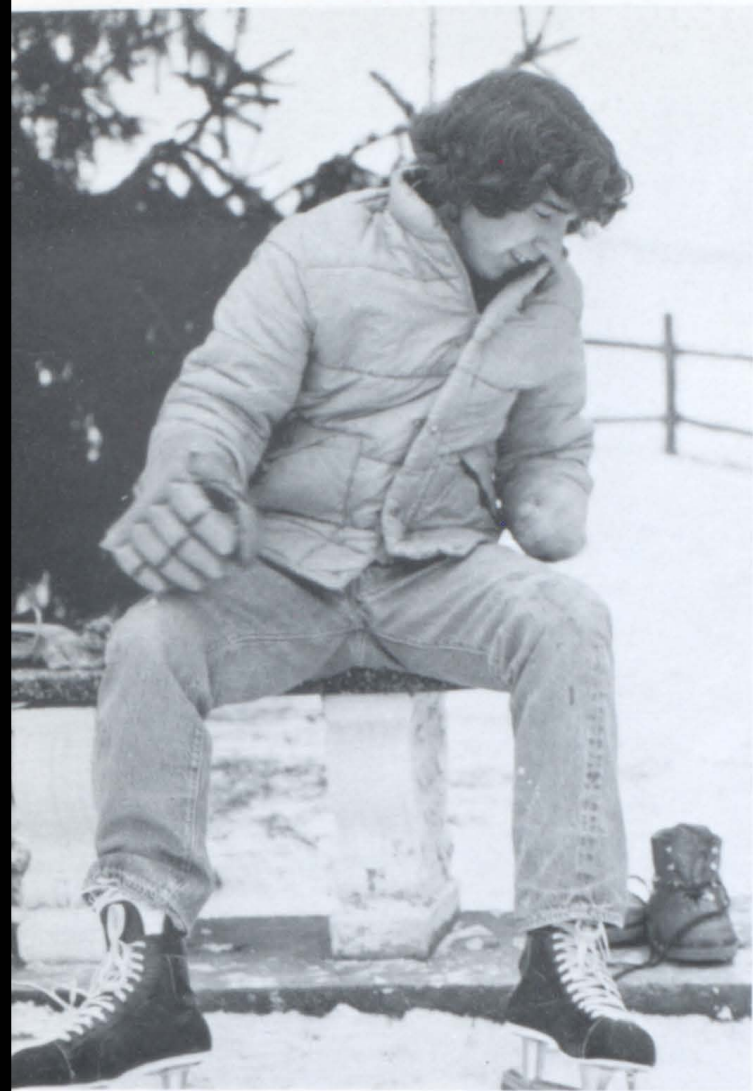

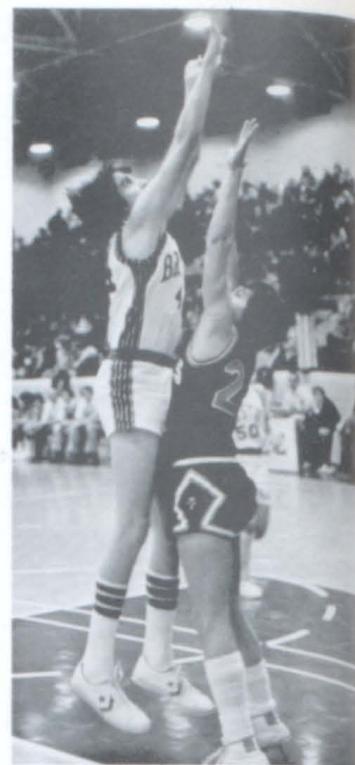
