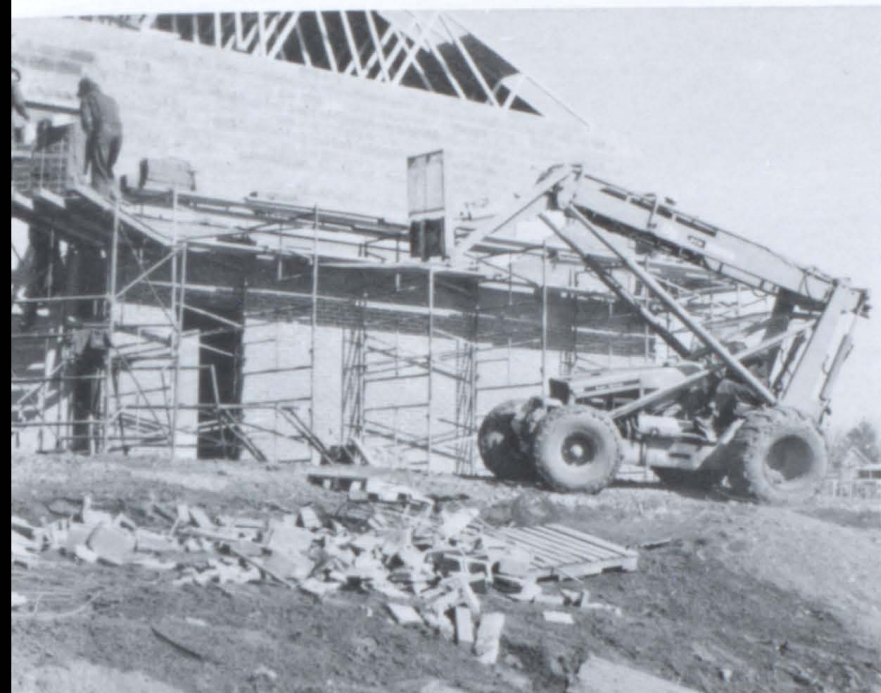
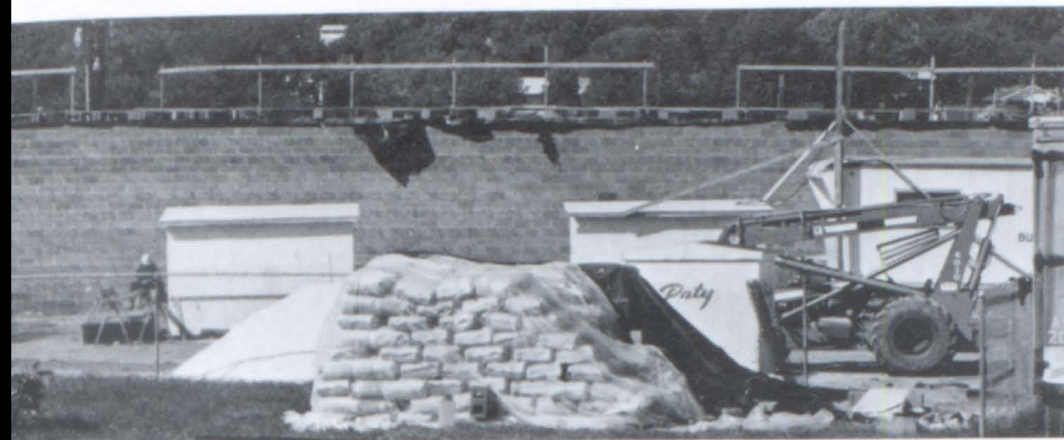


A TIME FOR EXPANSION

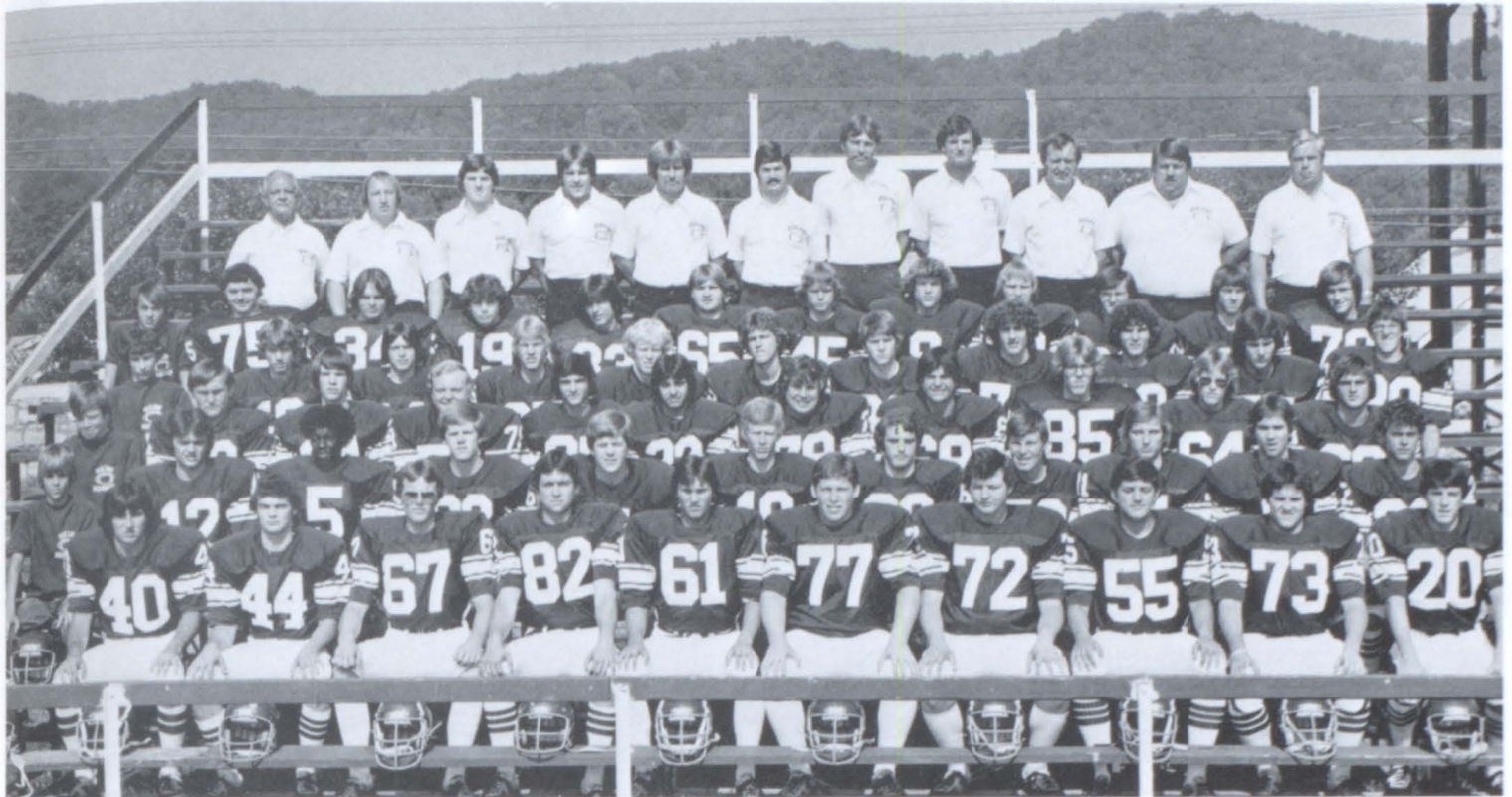

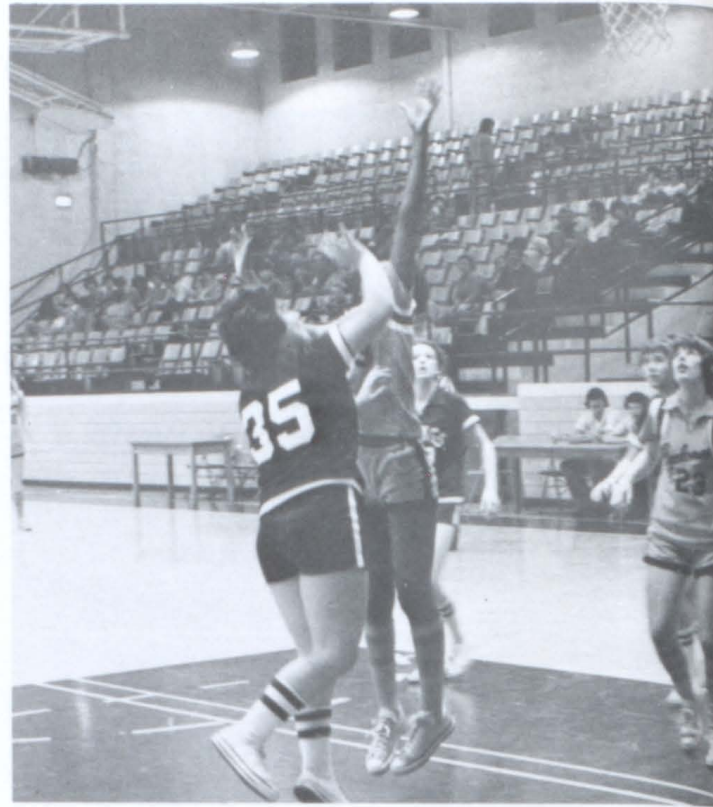
